Rep. Austerman,

Our lead attorney on HB 301 was out of town when the original amendment from Rep. Stoltze was adopted in House Finance, and when he came back and reviewed it, he noticed one minor technical error. The amendment adopted by House Finance pointed to a specific section in terms of citations and penalties. This could be narrowly construed to exclude the use of other forms of penalties. Therefore, we recommend referencing the range of penalty statutes. In discussing this with our criminal division, they also recommend the change so as not to tie their hands.

Please let me know if you would be open to offering this amendment, and if you would like any more information.
