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Analysis

AS 21.42 would be amended to require insurance companies to offer children who are residents a child-only health insurance policy on a guaranteed-issue basis during an open enrollment period from January 1 through March 31 each year. "Child" is defined as an individual under 19 years of age.

This bill has no fiscal impact on the division of insurance.
