TO: HB 292

1 Page 10, following line 13:

2 Insert a new bill section to read:

3 **\*\* Sec. 20.** AS 39.52.960(11) is amended to read:

4 (11) "immediate family member" means

5 (A) the spouse of the person;

6 (B) another person cohabiting with the person in a conjugal  
7 relationship that is not a legal marriage;

8 (C) a child, including a stepchild and an **adopted**  
9 [ADOPTIVE] child, of the person;

10 (D) a parent, sibling, grandparent, aunt, or uncle of the person;

11 and

12 (E) a parent or sibling of the person's spouse;"

14 Renumber the following bill sections accordingly.
