Dear Senator Menard,

I understand that you recently introduced and the 27<sup>th</sup> Alaska State Legislature is considering Senate Bill 2, an act relating to National Rifle Association special request license plates. Further, it has been conveyed that you are considering expanding this legislation to include breast cancer awareness specialty plates. This correspondence serves as notice that the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) does not object to the proposed legislation nor its expansion to include breast cancer awareness.

Should SB 2 become law, the DMV will work with the designated entities on a potential design for each plate. The DMV will also consult law enforcement to ensure that officers can easily identify the plate number for their purposes. The designs will then go before the Commissioner of Administration for final approval.
