**A BILL****FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**1   **"An Act relating to National Rifle Association special request license plates."**2   **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**3    \* **Section 1.** AS 28.10.181 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4                   (bb) Special request plates commemorating the National Rifle Association.

5           Upon application by the owner of a motor vehicle, the department may issue

6           registration plates commemorating the National Rifle Association. The commissioner,

7           after consulting with representatives of the National Rifle Association in Alaska, shall

8           determine the design and color of the plates. The department may disapprove the

9           issuance of registration plates under this subsection when the requested plates are a

10          duplication of an existing registration.

11   \* **Sec. 2.** AS 28.10.421(d) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

12                   (20) special request National Rifle Association plates ..... \$50

13           plus the fee required for that vehicle under (b), (c), (h), or (i) of this section; the \$50

14           fee required by this paragraph shall be collected only on the first issuance and on the

15           replacement of special request plates; a \$30 fee shall be collected biennially thereafter

1 in the same manner as the fee required under (b), (c), (h), or (i) of this section; the  
2 commissioner of administration shall separately account for the fees received under  
3 this paragraph that the department deposits into the general fund; notwithstanding (g)  
4 of this section, the annual estimated balance in the account that is in excess of the cost  
5 of issuing special request plates may be appropriated by the legislature to establish and  
6 maintain a scholastic clay target program and for other youth shooting programs.
