KEY OUTCOMES

Employment - 62 re-entrant hires in January

Employers - Over 629 employers willing to hire program participants

Housing - Over 116 landlords willing to rent to program participants

Financial Management - Money Management, Inc. consults with 16 – 20 participants each month to review credit reports and educate on budget management.

Peer-to-Peer Groups – PRC hosts 2 Peer Groups, which meet weekly. The average number of participants who attend each week is 18.

MRT – Moral Reconciliation Therapy. This is offered on Wednesday nights and the attendance varies.

Vivitrol Pilot Program. 32 offered this option to date (Pilot Program began 9/15)
19 have accepted the program
13 have declined
11 of the 13 who declined the program are re-incarcerated
1 of the 19 in the program, who refused the 2nd month Vivitrol injection, is re-incarcerated
