The Native Village of Diomede IRA, supports the HB 63 Bill.

Little Diomede, Alaska is located 27 miles from mainland and is NW of Nome, AK. Diomede holds a population of 130 residents. Every year the community residents dump 8 tons of solid waste onto the ice. Diomede does not have proper incineration, and because the island is an all rocky steep island and about a 1/4 mile beachway, there is no landfill. It has become a custom to cast trash onto the ice. The Native Village of Diomede IRA, does collect recyclables, but can only send space available in the winter season by plane.
