FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA

Analysis

This legislation creates an Office of Entrepreneurship in the department. The original version of the bill waived business license fees for the first five years if a business has its principal place of business in Alaska. As amended, this legislation no longer impacts the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing.

Business licensing at CBPL is funded by General Fund/Program Receipts fund source 1005 GF/Prgm (DGF). Business licensing fees are set per AS 43.70, and revenue in excess of authorized budgeted expenses reverts to the State of Alaska general fund.
