## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA

BILL NO. HB 114

### Analysis

This legislation amends AS 18.60.270 to create a \$10 fee for each boiler or unfired pressure vessel inspection report filed without using the department's online direct-entry system or other nonelectronic forms provided by the department. This legislation also reduces the time allowed to file a report from 30 days following a boiler or unfired pressure vessel inspection to 15 days.

Using the current number of boiler or unfired pressure vessel inspection reports filed on nonelectronic forms, the department estimates that this legislation will result in an additional \$32,000 in revenue each year. The fees from this legislation will be deposited into the Building Safety Account, which is classified as designated general fund (DGF). Actual revenue will vary depending on the amount of fees assessed.

Provided below is the methodology used for estimating the annual revenue increase.
