**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Commending and supporting actions taken by the Office of the Governor and the**  
2 **attorney general to protect the state from federal government incursion into the care**  
3 **and management of state resources and to promote the economic prosperity of the state;**  
4 **and urging the United States Congress and the President of the United States to limit**  
5 **federal government overreach into management of state resources.**

6 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

7 **WHEREAS** the federal government is attempting regulatory actions that are adverse  
8 and contrary to the interests of the state and its citizens; and

9 **WHEREAS** the Office of the Governor and attorney general, with strong support by  
10 the leadership of the Alaska State Legislature, have challenged the federal government in  
11 court for its misuse of the Endangered Species Act in its expansive designation of critical  
12 habitat for polar bears, for restricting access to Alaska rivers, and for taking adverse actions  
13 against our timber interests, mining interests, and interests in development of federal onshore  
14 and outer continental shelf oil and gas resources; and

15 **WHEREAS**, under art. VIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, the policy of

1 the state is to encourage the development of its resources by making them available for  
2 maximum use consistent with the public interest; and

3 **WHEREAS** actions taken by the state's executive and the leadership of the Alaska  
4 State Legislature seek to protect the collective interests of the people of the state and promote  
5 a future of economic security and prosperity;

6 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature commends and supports the  
7 actions of the Office of the Governor and the attorney general to protect the state from federal  
8 government incursion into the care and management of state resources and to promote the  
9 economic prosperity of the state; and be it

10 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature urges the United States  
11 Congress and the President of the United States to limit federal government overreach into  
12 management of state resources.

14 the United States; the Honorable Joseph R. Biden, Jr., Vice-President of the United States and  
15 President of the U.S. Senate; and the Honorable Lisa Murkowski and the Honorable Mark

17 Alaska delegation in Congress.
