BILL NO. HB 263

Analysis

This bill exempts certain water taxi operators from regulation by the Big Game Commercial Services Board in the same way that air taxis are exempted as transportation services for big game hunters, their equipment, or big game animals harvested by hunters if this is an incidental segment of their business operation.

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) does not regulate transportation services related to big game hunters, their equipment, or harvest. This function is performed by the Big Game Commercial Services Board in the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development. Furthermore, ADF&G does not handle records of the activities of these operators or big game guides. Therefore, this legislation does not have an operational or fiscal impact on ADF&G.
