7 including the appropriations made in sec. 56, ch. 7, SLA 2024, the amount necessary to
8 balance revenue and general fund appropriations that take effect in fiscal year 2025 that are
9 made in this Act, as passed by the Thirty-Fourth Alaska State Legislature and enacted into
10 law, and the general fund appropriations that take effect in fiscal year 2025 that are made in
11 ch. 7, SLA 2024, ch. 8, SLA 2024, and ch. 9, SLA 2024, not including the appropriations
12 made in sec. 56, ch. 7, SLA 2024, is appropriated to the general fund from the budget reserve
13 fund (art. IX, sec. 17, Constitution of the State of Alaska).

14 (b) If, after the appropriation made in (a) of this section, the unrestricted state revenue
15 available for appropriation in fiscal year 2025 is insufficient to cover the general fund
16 appropriations that take effect in fiscal year 2025, not including the appropriations made in
