Good afternoon, Remond.

The information provided detailing a break-down of the Alaskan Native population in DOC custody is in response to a question asked during the House Finance Committee hearing on Monday, 2/26 regarding a discussion on subcommittee amendment House DOC 4. We are happy to discuss this further should you have additional questions.

As of 2/28/18, there are 163 unsentenced individuals at the Yukon Kuskokwim Correctional Center (YKCC) and 15 sentenced, making a total population of 178 individuals. Please see the chart below for a summary of the sentenced population:

Regarding the unsentenced population, Superintendent Dean Marshall of YKCC shared that the Bethel court does not provide documentation on convictions. They are provided documentation after sentencing. Thus the interim status is not something that is tracked at the YKCC facility.

However, the information Representative Wilson asked for, which Commissioner Williams indicated he could provide, was the number of inmates at YKCC that were sentenced, unsentenced and in Pre-Trial status. Specifically, Representative Wilson would like to know how many inmates in the YKCC unsentenced population have not been convicted of an offense at this point and are essentially in Pre-Trial status?

Also, in your February 14, 2018 email to Representative Kawasaki's office, you indicated that the department could provide a detailed profile of the YKCC population upon request. This information would be much appreciated as well.

Thank you in advance for your assistance. Representative Wilson looks forward to your response.
