12 A RESOLUTION URGING GOVERNOR WALKER TO CLOSE AREAS ADJACENT TO  
13 DENALI NATIONAL PARK AND PRESERVE TO THE TRAPPING AND HUNTING OF  
14 BEARS, WOLVES AND WOLVERINES

16

17 WHEREAS, Over a half a million annual visitors from around the world  
18 come to Denali National Park and Preserve, in large part, to see the iconic wolves and  
19 bears of the Park; and  
20

21 WHEREAS, Both the Park and commercial tour companies advertise  
22 Denali National Park and Preserve as the best place in the world to see wolves within  
23 their natural habitat; and  
24

25 WHEREAS, A large percentage of these visitors come to Fairbanks  
26 because of our proximity to the Park; and  
27

28 WHEREAS, Hunters and trappers are allowed to use bait in the 22 mile  
29 long corridor, commonly referred to as the Wolf Townships or Stampede Trail corridor,  
30 to lure bears and wolves out of Denali National Park and Preserve and kill them; and  
31

32 WHEREAS, The East Fork Pack was the most famous, the most studied  
33 and most viewed wolf-pack in the world and has now been decimated by hunters and  
34 trappers using bait to draw them just outside the Park boundary; and  
35

36 WHEREAS, When this area was closed to hunting and trapping the East  
37 Fork Pack numbered 22; but has now been reduced to a single female wolf trying to  
38 raise pups alone; and  
39

40 WHEREAS, When the Wolf Townships/Stampede Trail was closed to  
41 hunting there were 140 wolves in Denali National Park and Preserve and 49% of visitors  
42 saw wolves. Now the East Fork Pack has been almost wiped out and the total number  
43 of wolves within Denali stands at 48 - an all-time low - and the number of visitors who  
44 see wolves, for the last three years, is only 4%, also an all-time low; and  
45

46 WHEREAS, This incredible and unique resource is being squandered for  
47 the satisfaction of just a handful of individuals; and  
48

49 WHEREAS, The Alaska economy cannot survive unless we have a  
50 diversified economy that promotes tourism and other industries besides oil.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Fairbanks North Star Borough  
urges the Governor, through the Commissioner of Fish and Game to close the areas  
adjacent to Denali National Park and Preserve to the trapping and hunting of bears,  
wolves and wolverines.
