FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

**STATE OF ALASKA
2018 LEGISLATIVE SESSION****Analysis**

This legislation repeals AS 06.20.030(c) exempting applicants for small loan licenses from the license fee for obtaining a business license. There are fewer than 10 licensees under this program. An Alaska business license cost is \$50 per year. The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional licensing will have nominal impact from this legislation.

Business licensing at CBPL is funded by General Fund/Program Receipts fund source 1005 GF/Prgm (DGF). Business licensing fees are set per AS 43.70, revenue in excess of authorized budgeted expenses reverts to the State of Alaska general fund.
