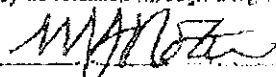

Thank you for allowing me the opportunity to express my desire to serve the State of Alaska on the Alaska Workers Compensation Board.

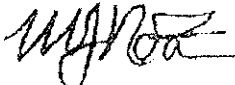
