## **HB 409 — VEHICLES; ID CARD, REGISTRAT., LICENSE FEES**

### **Explanation of Changes ver D to Ver O.A**

#### **Section 3**

Adds a conforming change to the repeal of the permanent registration in Section 18 of this bill.

#### **Section 5**

Version D raised the vehicle registration fee for charitable organizations from \$10 to \$50. An amendment on the House Floor returned the fee to \$10.

#### **Section 6**

Adds a conforming change to the repeal of the permanent registration in Section 18 of this bill.

#### **Section 7**

Adds a conforming change to the repeal of the permanent registration in Section 18, prohibiting a municipality from establishing a tax on vehicles that remain covered under the permanent registration provision.

#### **Section 14**

Version D of the bill changed the requirement for proof of financial responsibility after a license suspension for failure to pay a judgement from lifetime to ten years. An amendment in House State Affairs changed the requirement from 10 years to 3 years. The amendment also added that the proof of financial responsibility requirements in this section only apply to uninsured drivers.

#### **Section 18**

An amendment in House Finance added a section repealing permanent vehicle registration for vehicles that are at least eight years old.

#### **Section 19**

Adds a section grandfathering in people who have already registered their vehicles under the permanent vehicle registration.
