It is the intent of the legislature that the following appropriations and projects are needed to carry out the state's energy policy described in AS 44.99.115. As the energy policy states, the legislature recognizes the immense diversity of the state's geography, cultures, and resource availability and the need to identify and assist with development of the most cost-effective, long-term sources of energy for each community statewide.
