Sectional Analysis

“An Act relating to voter preregistration for minors at least 16 years of age.”

Section 1 – Amends *AS 15.07.040*: Changes when Alaska residents can pre-register to vote to 16 years of age. Current statute allows citizens who are 17 years old to be able to register to vote within 90 days of their 18th birthday.
