This legislation appears to move powers and duties of the Division of Agriculture AS 03.05, AS 03.22, AS 03.40, AS 03.90, AS 44.3 from the Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources to the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce and Economic Development. The current legislation does not address the Agricultural Revolving Loan Fund including asset properties including Mt. McKinley Meat & Sausage and the Board of Agriculture and Conservation which is currently managed by the Division of Agriculture. The Division also has nine properties and two leases with an estimated replacement value of \$7,037.5. Including the North Latitude Plant Materials Center. Effective date of bill may impact current fiscal year programs and estimate of cost.
