DD – Dishonorable Discharge for Enlisted. Dismissal for Officers.

There are two categories of discharges – Administrative and Punitive.

Administrative discharges are done administratively. Punitive discharges are done through courts-martial. The administrative discharges are Honorable, General, and Other Than Honorable. The punitive discharges are Bad Conduct Discharge and Dishonorable. Officers would receive a dismissal which is the equivalent to a dishonorable discharge.
