Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the questions asked by the House Finance Committee. During the bill hearing for House Bill 91 on April 30, 2025, one question was raised that required additional follow up. Please see the question and answer below.

1. Provide the stand-alone numbers for the anticipated revenue from just the sales tax in HB 91.

The fiscal note for HB 91 includes the net estimated change in revenues from all changes in the bill. Below are the stand-alone estimated sales tax numbers for HB 91:

For FY2026, the sales tax represents a half-year of revenue because of the mid-year effective date of the proposed sales tax.
