BILL NO. SSHB 251

Analysis

HB 251 would allow a non-Alaskan licensed veterinarian to practice in Alaska if they do so “without compensation”. However, they may receive “actual expenses incurred” for their service. This bill adds a new section to Veterinarian statutes that restricts the Board’s ability to receive a voluntarily surrendered license. Language was added to define “professional incompetence” and also restricts who may file a complaint against a veterinarian licensee to those who own or have responsibility for the care of the animal, how an investigation is to be conducted, and which board members may vote on a disciplinary action.

HB 251 has no fiscal impact to the division.
