RE: Support SJR2

Dear Alaska State Affairs Committee:

I support SJR2 but certainly not because Senator Matt Claman introduced it. Matt, is this part of your Gubernatorial Campaign?

I apologize that I must be very critical of Mr. Claman. I am going to label Mr. Claman a “wolf in sheep’s clothes.” I am married to Thomas S. Obermeyer, Missouri Attorney since 1990, but still not licensed to practice law in Alaska having been denied reciprocity here although Missouri has reciprocity with Alaska. Tom has taken a total of 49 Alaska Bar Exams, presumably a test of minimal competency, for a total of 143 days of his life (45 Exams X 3 days = 135 days 4 Exams X 2 days = 8 days).

Mr. Claman has been a member, Alaska Bar Assn. since 1988. He was a member and President, Alaska Bar Assn. Bd. of Governors 2003-2008, during which time Thomas S. Obermeyer, Attorney, faithfully and conscientiously paid for, studied for, and took Alaska Bar Exam. Tom got no help at any time from Matt or Alaska Bar Assn. Bd. of Govs. Ethical people and especially attorneys do not take a person’s money once without a thought of helping one of their own. Instead, Matt and Alaska Bar Assn. have been a “brick wall” as they continued to take Tom’s money for over three decades or 31 years.

Mr. Claman was elected to Anchorage Assembly, 2007-2010 and Acting Mayor, 2009. He was elected 2014-2016, Alaska House of Representatives and became a Member and Chair, Alaska Judiciary Committee. He was elected to Alaska Senate and became Senate Judiciary Committee Chair 1/18/17 to Current. He has been in Alaska Legislature for going on 12 years.

Matt, why did you wait 11 years until 1/22/25 to introduce SJR2? Is this part of your Gubernatorial Campaign? I do not support you and think you owe Tom Obermeyer an apology.

Senate State Affairs, do not believe in Matt.
