A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act amending the termination date of certain statutes relating to the use, operation,**
2 **and regulation of boats, a uniform state waterway marking system, and civil liability for**
3 **boat owners; providing for an effective date by amending the effective date of secs. 3, 5,**
4 **7, 9, 11, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 26, and 27, ch. 28, SLA 2000, as amended; and providing for**
5 **an effective date."**

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

7 * **Section 1.** Section 30, ch. 28, SLA 2000, as amended by sec. 3, ch. 34, SLA 2004, by sec.
8 1, ch. 19, SLA 2009, and by sec. 1, ch. 47, SLA 2010, is amended to read:

9 Sec. 30. Sections 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 26, and 27 of this Act take
10 effect [ON THE EARLIER OF THE FOLLOWING DATES:

11 (1) JULY 1, 2013; OR

12 (2)] 90 days after the date the chair of the Alaska Legislative Council
13 notifies the revisor of statutes that in the previous state fiscal year the state did not

1 receive and does not anticipate receiving federal funding for a statewide boating and
2 safety education program; the director of the division of legislative finance shall notify
3 the chair of the Alaska Legislative Council when the state, in the previous fiscal year,
4 did not receive federal funding for a statewide boating and safety program; the chair of
5 the Alaska Legislative Council may not give the notice described in this section
6 [PARAGRAPH] unless the notice is approved by a vote of a majority of the members
7 of the Alaska Legislative Council.

8 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
