10 pay or agree to pay an amount, based on the number of signatures collected.
11 Nothing in this subsection prohibits a person or an organization from employing
12 a circulator and paying the circulator an hourly wage or salary that is not based
13 on the number of signatures collected [THAT IS GREATER THAN \$1 A
14 SIGNATURE, FOR THE COLLECTION OF SIGNATURES ON A PETITION]."

6 **** Sec. 27. AS 19.25.105(a) is amended to read:**

7 (a) Outdoor advertising may not be erected or maintained within 660 feet of
8 the nearest edge of the right-of-way and visible from the main-traveled way of the
9 interstate, primary, or secondary highways in this state except the following:

10 (1) directional and other official signs and notices that [WHICH]
11 include [, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO,] signs and notices pertaining to natural
12 wonders, scenic and historic attractions, which are required or authorized by law, and
13 which shall conform to federal standards for interstate and primary systems;

14 (2) signs, displays, and devices advertising the sale or lease of property
15 upon which they are located or advertising activities conducted on the property;

16 (3) signs determined by the state, subject to concurrence of the United
17 States Department of Transportation, to be landmark signs, including signs on farm
18 structures or natural surfaces of historic or artistic significance, the preservation of
19 which would be consistent with the provisions of this chapter;

20 (4) directional signs and notices pertaining to schools;

21 (5) advertising on bus benches or bus shelters, and adjacent trash
22 receptacles, if the state determines that the advertising conforms to local, state, and
23 federal standards for interstate and primary highways;

1 **(6) temporary political campaign signs not larger than 32 square**
2 **feet in size displayed on private property if the owner or resident of the property**
3 **is not being compensated for the display, the sign is not a risk to the public, and**
4 **the sign is outside of an interstate, primary, or secondary highway right-of-way."**
