Senate Bill 210 – Indigenous Cultural Heritage Education

Sectional Analysis - Version A

Sec. 1 Amends AS 14.03.015 by adding a new subsection (b) to:

Encourage K-12 students and educators to learn about the unique cultural heritages of Alaska Natives and American Indians by requiring public schools to work cooperatively with tribes through consultation and contracting. This will provide educators with the means to gain an understanding and appreciation of Alaska Native and American Indian people, and lead to more locally designed classroom activities, curricula, and programming.
