FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act providing for an exception to allow drivers of public utility motor vehicles to
- 2 operate those vehicles with certain screen devices operating and visible to the drivers."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * **Section 1.** AS 28.35.161(c) is amended to read: 5 (c) Subsections (a) and (b) of this section do not apply to 6 (1) portable cellular telephones or personal data assistants being used 7 for verbal communication or displaying caller identification information; 8 (2) equipment that is displaying only 9 (A) audio equipment information, functions, and controls; 10 (B) vehicle information or controls related to speed, fuel level, 11 battery charge, and other vehicle safety or equipment information; 12 (C) navigation or global positioning; 13 (D) maps;

(E) visual information to

1	(1) enhance or supplement the driver's view forward,
2	behind, or to the sides of the motor vehicle for the purpose of
3	maneuvering the vehicle; or
4	(ii) allow the driver to monitor vehicle occupants seated
5	behind the driver;
6	(F) vehicle dispatching and response information for motor
7	vehicles providing emergency road service or roadside assistance;
8	(G) vehicle dispatching information for passenger transport or
9	freight or package delivery; [OR]
10	(H) information for use in performing highway construction,
11	maintenance, or repair or data acquisition by the Department of Transportation
12	and Public Facilities or a municipality; or
13	(I) information for use in performing utility construction,
14	maintenance, repair, or data acquisition by a public utility; in this
15	subparagraph, "public utility" has the meaning given in AS 42.05.990.
