7 "*** Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska enacted in sec. 31, ch. 47, SLA 1998,
8 as amended by sec. 2, ch. 46, SLA 2001, and sec. 2, ch. 38, SLA 2005, is amended to read:

9 Sec. 31. TEMPORARY BOARD MEMBER. After considering
10 recommendations made by the Alaska chapter of the American Society of Landscape
11 Architects, the governor shall appoint a landscape architect to the Board of
12 Registration for Architects, Engineers, and Land Surveyors. The person appointed
13 under this section

14 (1) must have been a resident in the state for three consecutive years
15 immediately preceding appointment;

16 (2) serves in an advisory, nonvoting capacity on the board;

17 (3) is entitled to receive state money for per diem or travel expenses
18 for work as a board member;

19 (4) serves a term that expires June 30, 2017 [2009]; and

20 (5) must be registered as a landscape architect under AS 08.48.

21 * **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
22 read:

23 TRANSITION: TEMPORARY BOARD MEMBER. The term of office of a person

1 holding a temporary position on the Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers, and Land
2 Surveyors before July 1, 2009, expires June 30, 2009. Unless the temporary member has
3 served all of two successive terms as described under AS 08.48.021(c), the temporary
4 member is eligible for reappointment under sec. 2 of this Act to a term beginning July 1,
5 2009, so long as the temporary member continues to meet the qualifications set out in sec. 2
6 of this Act. The temporary member may remain in the position until the governor names a
7 new appointee or reappoints the temporary member.

8 * **Sec. 4.** Section 2 of this Act takes effect July 1, 2009.

9 * **Sec. 5.** Except as provided in sec. 4 of this Act, this Act takes effect immediately under
10 AS 01.10.070(c)."
