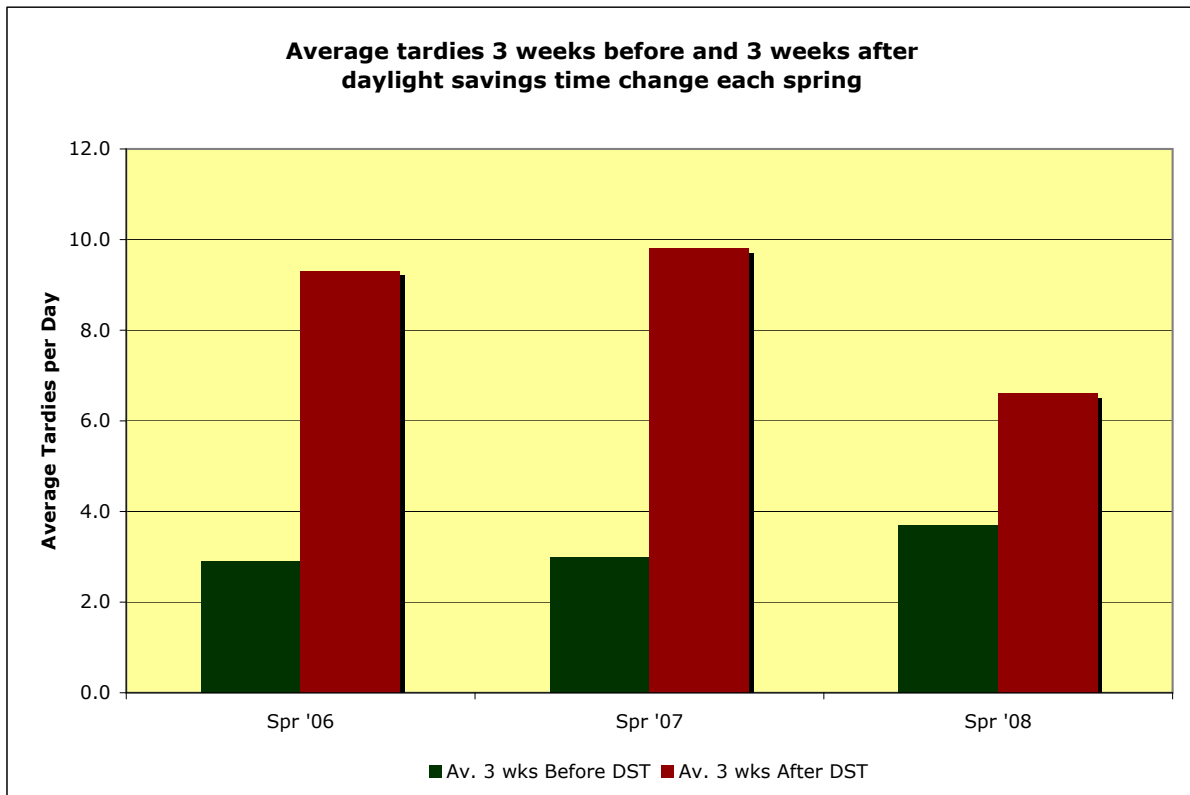


## Lewis Angapak Memorial School Over a Three Year Period
