**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1   **"An Act repealing the authority for day fines."**

2   **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3    \* **Section 1.** AS 12.55.035(a) is amended to read:

4           (a) **Upon** [EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN AS 12.55.036, UPON] conviction of  
5           an offense, a defendant may be sentenced to pay a fine as authorized in this section or  
6           as otherwise authorized by law.

7    \* **Sec. 2.** AS 12.55.035(b) is amended to read:

8           (b) **Upon** [EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN AS 12.55.036, UPON] conviction of  
9           an offense, a defendant who is not an organization may be sentenced to pay, unless  
10          otherwise specified in the provision of law defining the offense, a fine of no more than  
11               (1) \$500,000 for murder in the first or second degree, attempted  
12          murder in the first degree, murder of an unborn child, sexual assault in the first degree,  
13          sexual abuse of a minor in the first degree, kidnapping, promoting prostitution in the  
14          first degree under AS 11.66.110(a)(2), or misconduct involving a controlled substance  
15          in the first degree;

- (2) \$250,000 for a class A felony;
- (3) \$100,000 for a class B felony;
- (4) \$50,000 for a class C felony;
- (5) \$10,000 for a class A misdemeanor;
- (6) \$2,000 for a class B misdemeanor;
- (7) \$500 for a violation.

\* **Sec. 3.** AS 12.55.035(c) is amended to read:

(c) **Upon** [EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN AS 12.55.036, UPON] conviction of an offense, a defendant that is an organization may be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding the greater of

(1) an amount that is

(A) \$1,000,000 for a felony offense or for a misdemeanor offense that results in death;

(B) \$200,000 for a class A misdemeanor offense that does not result in death;

(C) \$25,000 for a class B misdemeanor offense that does not result in death;

(D) \$10,000 for a violation;

(2) three times the pecuniary gain realized by the defendant as a result of the offense; or

(3) three times the pecuniary damage or loss caused by the defendant to another, or to the property of another, as a result of the offense.
