Estimated cost for Commercial Fisheries Division Participation in a Board of Fisheries Meeting Prepared by Commercial Fisheries Division: John Hilsinger, Director April 2, 2009

Below are the estimated costs for the Commercial Fisheries Division to participate in a typical 10 – 12 day Board of Fisheries meeting such as might occur for Bristol Bay, Cook Inlet, or Southeast Alaska.

These figures will vary depending on meeting length, location, and proportion of staff that have to travel. A 12 day meeting with all staff traveling probably represents the highest cost that a single meeting would incur. Most such meetings would probably range from \$275,000 to 300,000 depending on location.
