A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to availability of state transportation facilities and state-owned or state-operated transportation modes for delivering compassionate aid."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

Sec. 44.19.051. Emergency assistance transportation; immunity. (a) If the governor determines that public safety or health conditions in an area of the state require emergency assistance, the governor may make available state transportation facilities, state-owned aircraft, vessels of the marine highway system, or railroad rolling stock of the Alaska Railroad for use by nonprofit organizations to deliver compassionate aid to the area, including food, water, fuel, clothing, medicine, and supplies.

(b) Notwithstanding another provision of law, the state and its officers, agents, and employees and the Alaska Railroad Corporation and its officers, agents, and employees are not liable in tort for damages for the injury to or death of a person or
