Dear Senator Reid, Senator McConnell, Speaker Pelosi and Representative Boehner:

The Council of State Governments (CSG), the only national association representing all three branches of state government, urges Congress and the Administration to engage state leaders in the development and implementation of a national economic recovery plan. CSG believes that any recovery package should include investments in programs critical to state economies, including infrastructure, education, and a temporary increase in the federal matching rate for Medicaid, while promoting state flexibility in program implementation.

While there remain differences of opinion among state leaders over the ideal scale and scope of an economic recovery package, CSG believes these investments are essential for meeting immediate economic needs while also addressing a mounting crisis in state finances that, if left unchecked, could lead to substantial reductions in critical state services. CSG also urges Congress and the Administration to avoid including restrictive provisions, such as strict maintenance of effort requirements, which limit the ability of state leaders to act quickly to meet individual states' economic conditions and to meet each state's unique needs.

In addition, CSG encourages Congress and the Administration to quickly reauthorize the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP). Improving health care access for our neediest citizens is a vital complement to any bipartisan recovery package. State flexibility has always been a hallmark of SCHIP and has contributed to its broad support. Flexibility to meet individual state circumstances should be maintained.
