FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act amending the termination date of certain statutes relating to the use, operation, 2 and regulation of boats, a uniform state waterway marking system, and civil liability for 3 boat owners; providing for an effective date by amending the effective date of secs. 3, 5, 4 7, 9, 11, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 26, and 27, ch. 28, SLA 2000, as amended; and providing for 5 an effective date." 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA: 7 * Section 1. Section 30, ch. 28, SLA 2000, as amended by sec. 3, ch. 34, SLA 2004, and by 8 sec. 1, ch. 19, SLA 2009, is amended to read: 9 Sec. 30. Sections 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 26, and 27 of this Act take 10 effect on the earlier of the following dates: 11 (1) July 1, <u>2016</u> [2011]; or 12 (2) 90 days after the date the chair of the Alaska Legislative Council 13 notifies the revisor of statutes that in the previous state fiscal year the state did not receive and does not anticipate receiving federal funding for a statewide boating and
safety education program; the director of the division of legislative finance shall notify
the chair of the Alaska Legislative Council when the state, in the previous fiscal year,
did not receive federal funding for a statewide boating and safety program; the chair of
the Alaska Legislative Council may not give the notice described in this paragraph
unless the notice is approved by a vote of a majority of the members of the Alaska
Legislative Council.
