Constitutional Mandate

- Apportionment
- Redistricting
- Distribution of Funds
- Count to President

"Representation and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their respective Numbers The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct."

Article I, Section 2 of the Constitution of the United States

- 10 questions, 10 minutes
- Short Form only
- Other ongoing surveys





2010 Census: It's Safe

The Data Collected are Completely Confidential

- Individual responses are safeguarded by Title XIII U.S.C
- Cannot share data with any one, including federal and local law enforcement agencies



Our Goal: Count Everyone

- Expect to mail, hand deliver, or personally enumerate 281,616 households in Alaska
- More than 681,000 residents
- 19,349 people in group quarters
- 663,268 square miles of land area
