A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to penalties for cruelty to animals."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. AS 11.61.140(f) is amended to read:
 - (f) Except as provided in (g) of this section, cruelty to animals <u>under (a)(2) or</u>
 (5) of this section is a class A misdemeanor. The court may also
 - (1) require forfeiture of any animal affected to the state or to a custodian that supplies shelter, care, or medical treatment for the animal;
 - (2) require the defendant to reimburse the state or a custodian for all reasonable costs incurred in providing necessary shelter, care, veterinary attention, or medical treatment for any animal affected;
 - (3) prohibit or limit the defendant's ownership, possession, or custody of animals for up to 10 years.
- * Sec. 2. AS 11.61.140(g) is amended to read:
 - (g) Cruelty to animals <u>under (a)(1), (3), or (4) of this section</u> is a class C felony. Cruelty to animals is also a class C felony if the person is convicted under

(a)(2) or (5) of this section and [IF] the person has been previously convicted on one
[TWO] or more separate occasions within 10 years of the date of the present offense
of a crime under this section, AS 11.61.145(a)(1) or (2), or a law or ordinance of
another jurisdiction having elements similar to those offenses. For a conviction
under this subsection, the [THE] court may also

- require forfeiture of any animal affected to the state or to a custodian that supplies shelter, care, or medical treatment for the animal;
- (2) require the defendant to reimburse the state or a custodian for all reasonable costs incurred in providing necessary shelter, care, veterinary attention, or medical treatment for any animal affected;
- (3) prohibit or limit the defendant's ownership, possession, or custody of animals for up to 10 years.
- * Sec. 3. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

APPLICABILITY. The changes to penalties under AS 11.61.140(f) and (g), made by secs. 1 and 2 of this Act, apply to offenses occurring on or after the effective date of this Act.
