- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- *** Section 1.** AS 44.88.030(a) is amended to read:
- 5 (a) The membership of the authority consists of
- 6 (1) the commissioner of revenue [AND THE COMMISSIONER OF
- 7 COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT]; and
- 8 (2) four [ONE OTHER PERSON APPOINTED BY THE
- 9 GOVERNOR WHO SERVES AS THE HEAD OF A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT
- 10 OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH; AND
- 11 (3) TWO] public members appointed by the governor <u>each of whom</u>
- has expertise in private sector business and possesses demonstrated leadership
- skills.

14	Development and Export Authority under AS 44.88.030(a), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act,
15	who are appointed after the effective date of this Act shall serve staggered terms as follows:
16	(1) one member shall serve a one-year term;
17	(2) one member shall serve a two-year term.
