#### A BILL

### FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to eligibility to serve on state boards or commissions."

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* Section 1. AS 39.05.100 is amended by adding new subsections to read:
  - (c) A person is not eligible to serve on a board or commission of the state government if the person sought nomination or became a candidate for elective state or federal office during the preceding year, unless holding a particular elective state or federal office is required by law for appointment.
  - (d) A member of a board or commission of the state government who seeks nomination or becomes a candidate for elective state or federal office terminates membership on the board or commission.
  - (e) In this section, a person seeks nomination or becomes a candidate if the person
  - (1) under regulations adopted by the Alaska Public Offices Commission to implement AS 15.13.100, indicates an intention to become a candidate for elective state executive or legislative office;

- \* Sec. 3. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

APPLICABILITY. AS 39.05.100(c) - (e), added by sec. 1 of this Act, and the amendment of AS 39.25.160(e) made by sec. 2 of this Act, apply only to

- (1) members of state boards, commissions, or authorities seeking nomination or becoming a candidate for elective state or federal office on or after the effective date of this Act; and
- (2) the eligibility for appointment to state boards, commissions, or authorities of persons seeking nomination or becoming a candidate for elective state or federal office on or after the effective date of this Act.
