This legislation amends AS 40.25.120 by adding a new section that states that a transcript of a recording of a 911 call is a public record, and makes it a crime for a person to knowingly play a recording of a 911 call on a broadcast medium.

This bill can be reasonably expected to impact the department in the following ways:

1. Requires the department to comply with public record requests for 911 calls by obtaining a copies of recordings (can be multiple recordings from multiple dispatch centers regarding the same incident).

2. Transcribe the recording(s)

3. Redact protected and confidential information from the transcription.

4. Document review and consultation with Detachment Commanders and Department of Law to assure that

release of the information will not impact ongoing criminal investigations.

5. Dissemination to requestor.

It is envisioned that to comply with this legislation the department would create a "clearinghouse" to process requests. This centralized location would be responsible for taking the aforementioned steps to provide the information in compliance with statue.

The department is requesting two range 10 employees to process the requests and perform the transcriptions, and one part time criminal justice tech to redact protected information, coordinate with the agencies involved and to supervise the process.
