FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to public access to legislative committee meetings during regular
- 2 legislative sessions by Internet broadcast."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 24.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 24.05.186. Access to committee meetings by Internet broadcast. Each room that is regularly used during regular legislative sessions for meetings of committees of the legislature shall be equipped with a fixed camera capable of producing an audio and video feed without an operator once turned on. During regular sessions of the legislature, each meeting of a standing, special, joint, or permanent interim committee, except for executive sessions, that is held in a room with a fixed camera shall be recorded and the live feed made immediately available to the public through Internet broadcast so that the public may easily observe and listen to the meeting while it is in progress. The electronic recordings produced by a fixed camera under this section are not public records and are not required to be retained or stored.
