 - council acting for the area in a city may regulate, fix, establish, and change the rates and charges imposed for a utility service provided to the municipality or its inhabitants by a utility that is not subject to regulation under AS 42.05 unless that utility is exempted from regulation under AS 42.05.711(a), (d) (k), (o), [OR] (p), or (q), or is exempted under regulations adopted under AS 42.05.810 from complying with all or
