The proposed bill will:  1. Provide statutory clarification for information sharing between the Office of Children's Services and the Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) for the administration of services, protection, rehabilitation, or supervision of any child or for actions by that agency to protect the public safety;  2. Allow individuals with a legitimate interest (such as former clients of DJJ, parents, legal guardians, and others) access to information in agency records; and  3. Streamline the public disclosure law while ensuring appropriate disclosure of certain information to protect the public.
There will be no fiscal impact to DJJ with this bill.
