A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to requirements for persons holding provisional drivers' licenses."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 28.15.055 is amended by adding new subsections to read:
- 4 (b) A person holding a provisional driver's license shall display in the rear window of each vehicle operated by the person a sticker issued by the department that identifies that the vehicle is operated by a provisional licensee. The department may charge a fee for the issuance of a sticker. Failure to display a sticker as required by this subsection is an infraction and may be punished by a fine of not more than \$300. However, a person charged with violating this section may not be convicted if the person
- 11 (1) has not previously been arrested, charged, or cited for a violation of 12 this section: and
- 13 (2) produces in court proof that the person has obtained and affixed the sticker required by this subsection.
 - (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a peace officer may not stop

1	or detain a motor vehicle to determine compliance with (b) of this section, or issue a
2	citation for a violation of (b) of this section, unless the peace officer has probable
3	cause to stop or detain the motor vehicle other than for a violation of (b) of this
4	section.
