FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to requirements for persons holding provisional drivers' licenses; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.15.055 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

- (b) A person holding a provisional driver's license shall display in the rear window of each vehicle operated by the person a moveable sticker issued by the department that identifies that the vehicle is operated by a provisional licensee. The department may charge a fee for the issuance of a sticker. Failure to display a sticker as required by this subsection is an infraction and may be punished by a fine of not more than \$200. However, a person charged with violating this section may not be convicted if the person
- (1) has not previously been arrested, charged, or cited for a violation of this section; and
 - (2) produces in court proof that the person has obtained and displayed
