Analysis

This bill provides for regulation and licensure of medical laboratory science professionals by the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development and by a Board of Medical Laboratory Science Professionals created under a new chapter in AS title 8. Under AS 44.64.030(a)(6), the office of administrative hearings (OAH) conducts hearings in licensing matters, including disciplinary actions, arising under AS title 8, and in some cases provides administrative law judges to serve as mediators in the cases. OAH does not anticipate that addition of this licensure category would increase the office's caseload beyond OAH's capacity to handle the cases at currently approved staffing levels. The cost to OAH of performing the services would be recovered from the department through interagency receipts, based on the time commitment required for hearings and mediations.
