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Analysis

The effective date of this bill is January 1, 2013.
The purpose of this bill is to establish a statutory procedure for converting manufactured homes to real property when they are permanently affixed to real property.
This bill would require the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to record in its records when a manufactured home is affixed and no longer subject to the titling requirements in Title 28. Conversely, the DMV would record when the manufactured home was severed and again subject to Title 28. The process to record this information with the DMV would be voluntary.
This bill will have only a small financial impact on the DMV. The DMV will absorb any implementation costs in its operating budget.

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
