1 **"An Act relating to qualifications for serving on a state board or commission; extending**
2 **the termination dates of the Board of Nursing, the Board of Dental Examiners, the**
3 **Board of Barbers and Hairdressers, the Big Game Commercial Services Board, the**
4 **Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, and the Alaska Seismic Hazards Safety Commission;**
5 **and providing for an effective date."**

(c) Notwithstanding another provision of law, a person convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude may not serve on a board or commission of the state government unless the conviction has been overturned on appeal or otherwise set aside. In this subsection, "felony involving moral turpitude" has the meaning given in AS 15.80.010.

* **Sec. 9.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

APPLICABILITY. Section 5 of this Act applies only to appointments made on or after the effective date of this Act.

* **Sec. 10.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

RETROACTIVITY. (a) Sections 1, 2, 4, 6, and 8 of this Act are retroactive to June 30, 2011.

(b) If this Act takes effect after June 30, 2012, secs. 3 and 7 of this Act are retroactive to June 30, 2012.

* **Sec. 11.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
