# STATE OF ALASKA 2011 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB9

## Analysis

This bill lowers the compulsory age for attendance by one year, from age 7 to 6; and extends the age of required attendance by two years, from age 16 to 18. The exception is if a student completes the 12th grade or graduates from a secondary school.

In FY2010 there were approximately 1,406 students between the ages of 16 and 18 that dropped out of public school after the October student count period. The average cost of a student run through the FY12 foundation formula is \$10,568. 1,406 x \$10,568 = \$14,858,608.
