**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1    **"An Act making a corrective amendment to the Alaska Statutes as recommended by the**  
2    **revisor of statutes by correcting the spelling of 'lorazepam' and providing an**  
3    **applicability section; and providing for an effective date."**

4    **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5        **\* Section 1.** AS 11.71.170(b) is amended to read:

6               (b) Schedule IVA includes, unless specifically excepted or unless listed in  
7               another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any  
8               quantity of the following substances, including their salts, isomers and salts of isomers  
9               whenever the existence of these salts, isomers, and salts of isomers is possible within  
10              the specific chemical designation:

12                               (2) chloral betaine;  
13                               (3) chloral hydrate;  
14                               (4) chlordiazepoxide;

- (5) clonazepam;
- (6) clorazepate;
- (7) diazepam;
- (8) ethchlorvynol;
- (9) ethinamate;
- (10) flurazepam;
- (11) lorazepam [LORAZEPAN];
- (12) mebutamate;
- (13) meprobamate;
- (14) methohexital;
- (15) methylphenobarbital, also known as mephobarbital;
- (16) oxazepam;
- (17) paraldehyde;
- (18) petrichloral;
- (19) phenobarbital;
- (20) prazepam;
- (21) alprazolam;
- (22) halazepam;
- (23) temazepam;
- (24) triazolam;
- (25) midazolam;
- (26) quazepam;
- (27) flunitrazepam;
- (28) [REPEALED
- (29)] ketamine hydrochloride.

\* **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

APPLICABILITY. AS 11.71.170(b)(11), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, corrects a typographical error in the spelling of "lorazepam" that has existed since its adoption in Ch. 45, SLA 1982. AS 11.71.170(b)(11), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to crimes committed before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
